

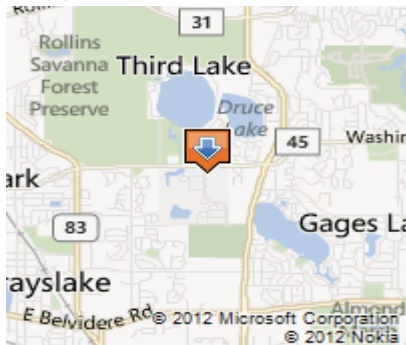
Balancing the Scales of Justice
